Comprehensive, Individualized Assistance

The Procurement Technical Assistance Program (PTAP) was established to expand the number of businesses capable of participating in government contracts. The program is administered by DLA's Office of Small Business Programs in cooperation with states, local governments and nonprofit organizations.

CT PTAC's Services Provided at No Charge!

One-on-one Counseling Assistance – State & federal registrations, Socio-Economic Certification, Contract administration, Marketing, Post-award functions, Subcontracting opportunities, Education and training, Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC), etc.

Bid-Match – Computerized service matching client businesses' capabilities to federal, state & local bids posted on the Internet.

Workshops, Seminars, Procurement Conferences – Relevant topics offered frequently in conjunction with other state & federal organizations and prime government contractors.

Resource Library – Includes pricing histories, military specs, the Federal Acquisition Regulation, state & local regulations and articles on government contract topics.

Expert Staff – Procurement Specialists are the bridge between businesses and buying offices, mentoring & monitoring firms from initial bid offering through contract completion.
